Viral Infection	Deva personnel, Site personnel and patients	<p>Consult and follow the latest NHS guidance relating to Coronavirus (Referenced above)</p> <p>Follow the PHE Guidelines for health professionals (Referenced above)</p> <p>Engineers to clean interior vehicle surfaces and tools / equipment with appropriate wipes/ cleaning materials</p> <p>Engineers will perform 20-second handwash with hot water and soap before commencing work, and completion of work, and before leaving site</p> <p>Engineers will cover mouth and nose with tissue if coughing or sneezing, discard tissue immediately and then perform a 20-second handwash with soap and hot water</p> <p>Engineers will comply with any measures that customer requires for safe working</p>	<p>Use of appropriate cleaning materials and procedures</p> <p>Availability of respiratory PPE where this is required (eg ward and theatre areas)</p>	<p>Availability of anti-viral wipes and/or cleaning materials.</p> <p>Use of respiratory PPE in ward and theatre areas</p> <p>It is expected that customer-provided PPE will be used to minimise cross-infection</p> <p>Customers should be asked about any specific extra measure that they require before work commences.</p>
